



One. Allah's Life, Knowledge, Will, & Power Two. Creation, Allah's Will, and His Command Three. Allah's Hearing, Seeing, & Speaking

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Part One. Lines 32-33: Allah's Life, Knowledge, Will, and Power

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Lines 32-33: Life, Knowledge, Will, and Power

32. The affirmative attributes are seven: / Namely, His Knowledge encompassing all things 33. His Life, Power, and Will....

One. Life (hayat)

Creator is necessarily Living Ayat al-Kursi [Q 2.255] {An eternal attribute of Allah, that is a condition for His being characterized by affirmative attributes.}



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Two. Knowledge (ilm)

Absolute, Eternal, unacquired, complete See: Q 57.3 {An eternal attribute of Allah, by which Allah knows all the necessary, possible, and impossible—without ever not having known it.}



Three. Will (irada)

Choice, specification Q 85.16 {An eternal attribute of Allah, by which Allah specifies some of the possible with some of what is possible for it.}



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Four. Power (qudra) Originates Q 2.284 {An eternal attribute of Allah, by which Allah brings originates the possible, in accordance with what He specifies with His Will.}

Will, Power, and Responsibility

لِقَدِ مَا فِي المَّنكَوْنَ وَمَا فِي الْأَرْضُ وَإِن تُبَدُوا مَا فِي ٱنْشَسِكُمْ أَوَ تُخْفُوهُ يُحَاسِبْكُمْ بِرِاللَّهُ فَيَغْفِرُ لِمَن يَمَا لَهُ وَيَعَذِبُ مَن يَمَا لَهُ وَاللَّهُ عَلَكَلِ عَنْهُ وَتَرِدُ ()

"Allah's is all that is in the heavens and all that is on the earth. Whether you reveal what is in your hearts or conceal it, Allah will call you to account for it. He forgives whoever He wills, and punishes whoever He wills. And Allah has complete Power over everything."

[Qur'an, 2.284]

Last verses of Surat al-Baqara: recommended Prophetic practice every night. "Whoever recites them, they will be sufficient for them."





 33. His Life, Power, and Will / Everything is only because He Willed it
34. This is true even if He commanded otherwise, / Allah's Will differs from His Command—so avoid vanity

35. So know that created things take four / Rulings in relation to His Will and Command, so understand

Three principles: (1) Everything happens by the Will of Allah. (2) Humans act with choice and are responsible. (3) Allah is Pleased with us when our choices and actions correspond to His Command.





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Part Three. Line 36: Hearing, Seeing, & Speaking

Five-Six. Hearing and Seeing

Distinct from Knowledge —mentioned distinctly in Qur'an [Eternal attributes of Allah, by which Allah hears and sees all existent things.]


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Seven. Speech (kalam)

Allah has ascribed Speech to Himself Eternal Attribute: indicates meanings—transcendent beyond words and sounds Qur'an: Speech of Allah *how?*







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
